















TRAVEL SAFE CODE OF CONDUCT.

- 1. Always wait safely away from the kerb or platform edge as approaching electric buses and trams are quiet and cannot stop quickly.
- 2. Purchase your tram ticket before it arrives and have your fare, pass or phone ready if you want to catch a bus.
- 3. Allow passengers to alight before you board.
- 4. Find a seat in which to travel and remain there but offer it if necessary to an elderly or disabled person.
- 5. If you have to stand hold on safely.
- 6. The top deck of a bus is seating only- no standing at any time there or on the stairs.
- 7. Behave respectfully at all times to other passengers and transport staff.
- 8. CCTV is shared with school head teachers and principals when students in uniform do not uphold this Code.
- 9. As you leave a bus, it is polite to say thank you or goodbye to the driver.
- 10. On the pavement or platform, be careful not to be distracted by your phone as the (quiet) bus or tram continues with its journey.
