First and foremost, you need to ensure that all of your notes are created for each section of the 2 Geography papers, you can use the exam board website to check what you need to know for each section.

Paper 1 units:

- A. The Challenge of Natural Hazards
- B. The Living World
- C. Physical Landscapes of the UK (options: Coasts and Rivers)

Paper 2 units:

- A. Urban Issues and Challenges
- B. The Changing Economic World
- C. Resource Management (option: Food)

Once your notes are completed it is then a case of trying to remember they key knowledge and understanding using methods such as 'Look-Cover-Test', where you spend time looking over your notes, then covering them and writing down what you can remember, after doing this you can look back over your notes again and add anything that you have missed or correct any mistakes.

Then once your knowledge is secure it is a case of trying to apply your knowledge and understanding to past exam papers, use the link above to access these, or you can speak to your Geography teacher to get access to these.

During the revision process, which is starting this week, students will be given one booklet for each of the 4 units of the course. This booklet has everything they need in one place – it includes the knowledge needed to get a grade 9 and past paper questions which have all been labelled 'class', 'period 6' or 'home'. Students need to check ClassCharts to see which pages they are expected to complete each week – we will also talk about it in lessons.

Students should use our YouTube videos to support them with both knowledge and exam technique. Stage 1 – Revising the knowledge

- Pick one area you are going to learn about (e.g. Treaty of Versailles which is part of the Paper 1 Conflict topic) and write down everything you know about the topic. This will show you what you already know and what areas you need to work on. Now watch the revision video and make notes as you do (doing something active is key!)
- At the end of the video, try a black pen, red pen activity. Write down everything you can remember about the topic in one colour (hopefully it's more than before). Then look back at the notes in your revision booklet and add anything you missed in a second colour
- You could then revisit the topic again a couple of hours later and try the same black pen, red pen activity
 again. Hopefully you will have more in your original colour. Revisiting information regularly is what helps
 you get it in to your long term memory

Stage 2 – Applying the knowledge to exam questions

- Watch one of the videos on exam technique relating to the content you just revised. You could go through them in order or you could pick the question type that you struggle most with. The videos include explanation of how to answer questions and a modelled example. They then give you time to pause the video and complete a full exam answer or exam plan it's important that you have a go! Then you can continue the video and see a model answer written by a teacher on that same question
- If you want even more questions to attempt use the class revision booklets. These have every single past paper question in it. We will go through these in lessons and period 6s but you could attempt any we haven't completed or those labelled 'home'. Remember your teacher will mark any questions that you write full answers to and we're happy to talk to you about any question you've found hard.

To revise **speaking**, ensure you know the answers to your questions as well as you can. Make sure these answers are **detailed**, **accurate** and include a good **variety of language** (not the same words repeated). You will be tested on these in lessons to ensure this revision is happening.

To revise **reading and listening**, practise with vocabulary on Memrise, and then apply it to past paper questions using the resources mentioned above. You can also access listening and reading tasks on Active Learn to get instant feedback on these skills.

If you get a question wrong, re-read or re-listen and see if you can find out why you were wrong – did you not give enough detail, was there a distractor, did you read the full sentence? Look up words you don't know and make vocabulary banks of these words so that you can revise them over time.

To revise **writing**, ensure you know **key tenses** (**past**, **present and future**) and apply these to example questions from your revision booklet and writing booklets that we have used in the back. Your teacher will mark these and give you feedback if you bring them in. Remember you can re-use your answers from speaking questions to answer written questions in your exam.

Revision technique

- Vocab for a module (e.g. Module 1)
- Attempt to adapt vocab into three tenses (past present & future)
- Complete Listening and Reading activity from past paper or revision guide on this topic
- Self-assess check what you could have done better and how to further improve
- Check answers in speaking booklet spend 15- 20 minutes revising these.
