# **A Level Results**

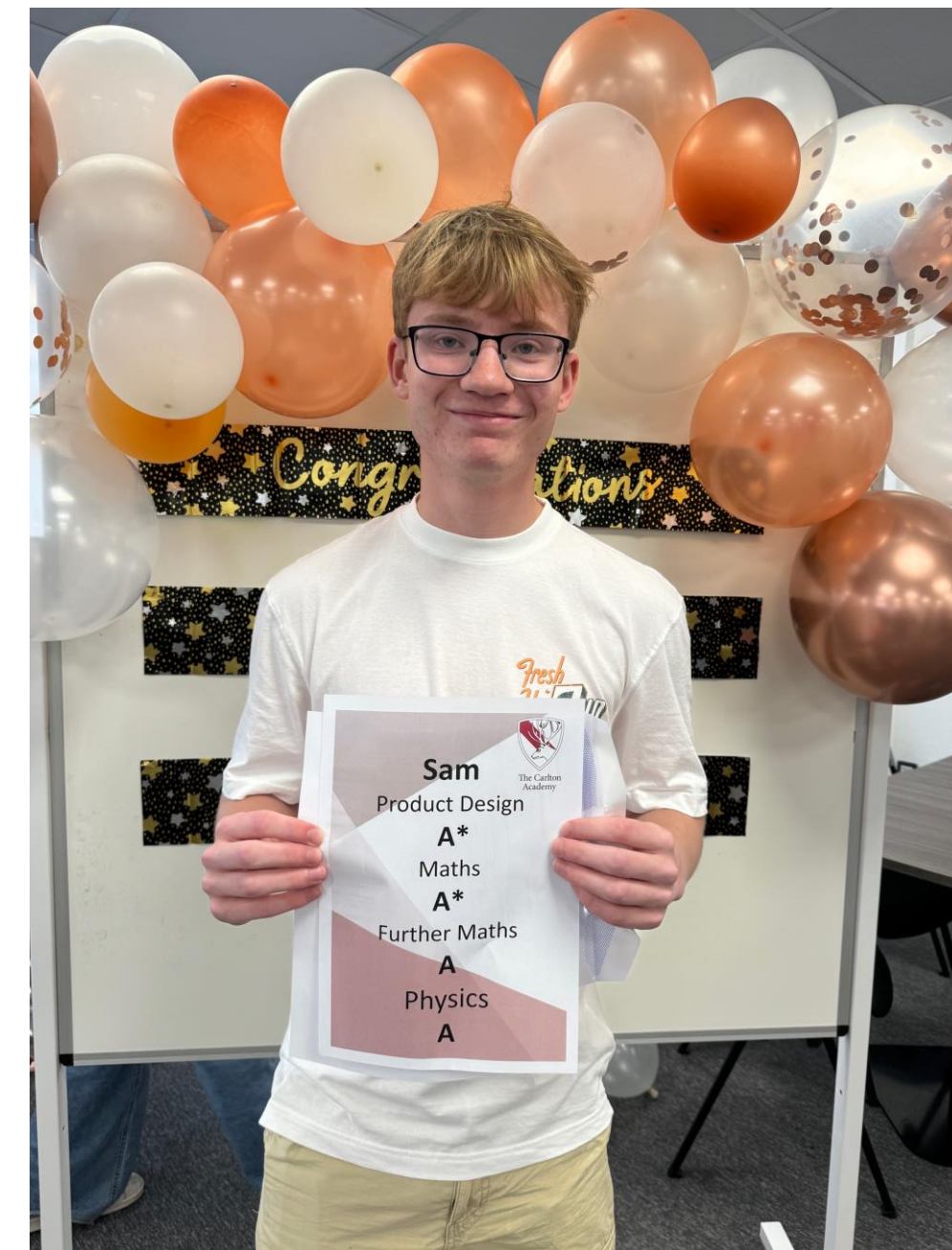
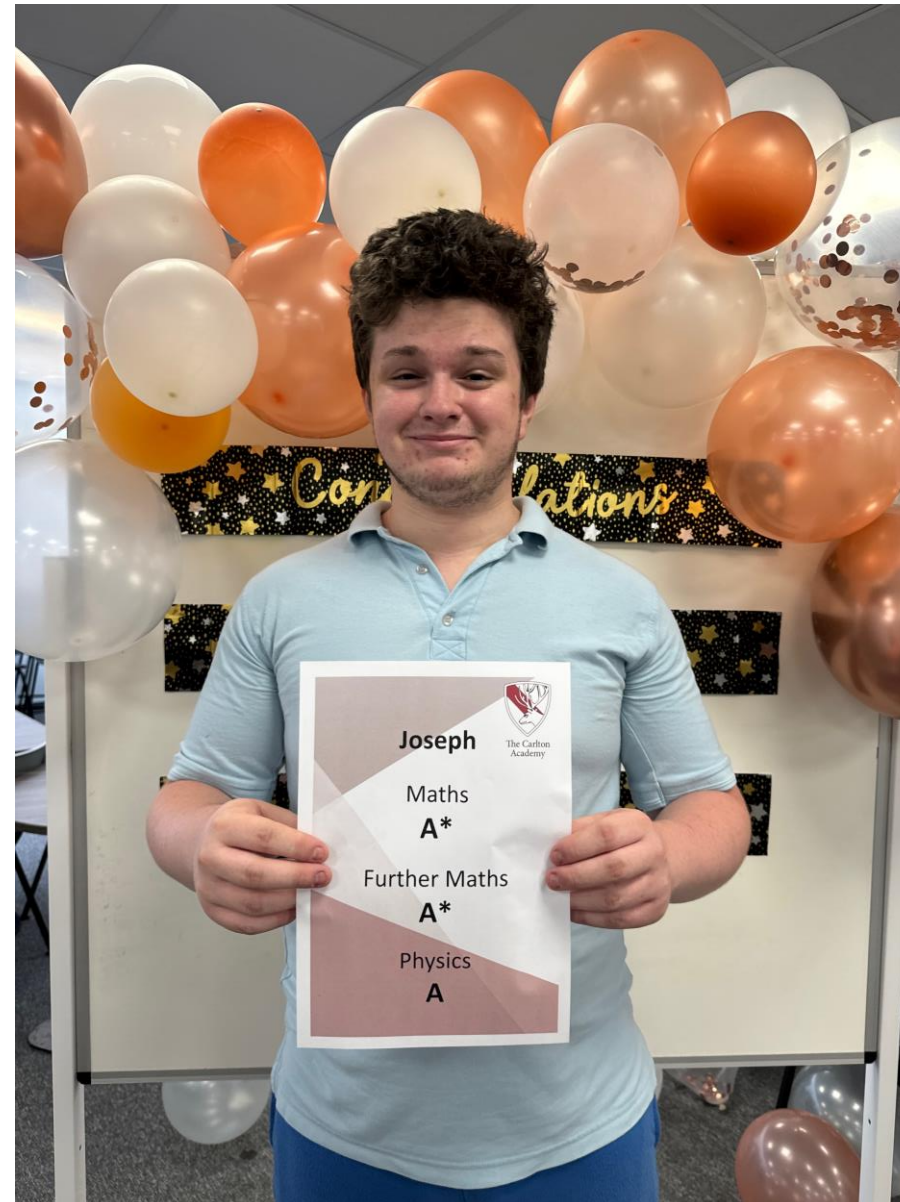
- 73% of our students progressed onto Higher Education in 2024.
- 94.4% A level pass rate.
- 15% achieved A\*-A grades.
- 45% achieved A\*-B grades (up from 39%)

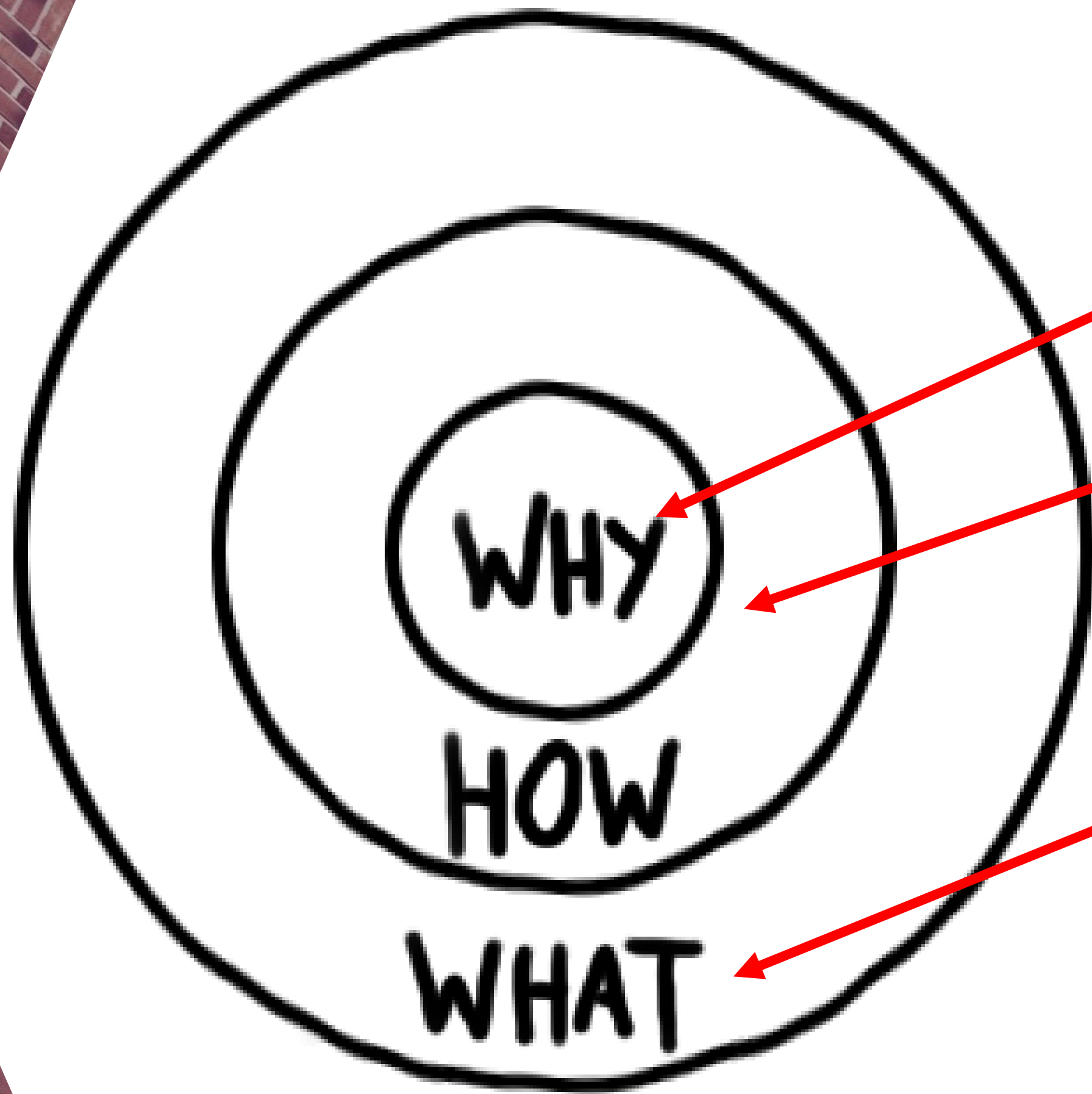

# How is Sixth Form different to college?

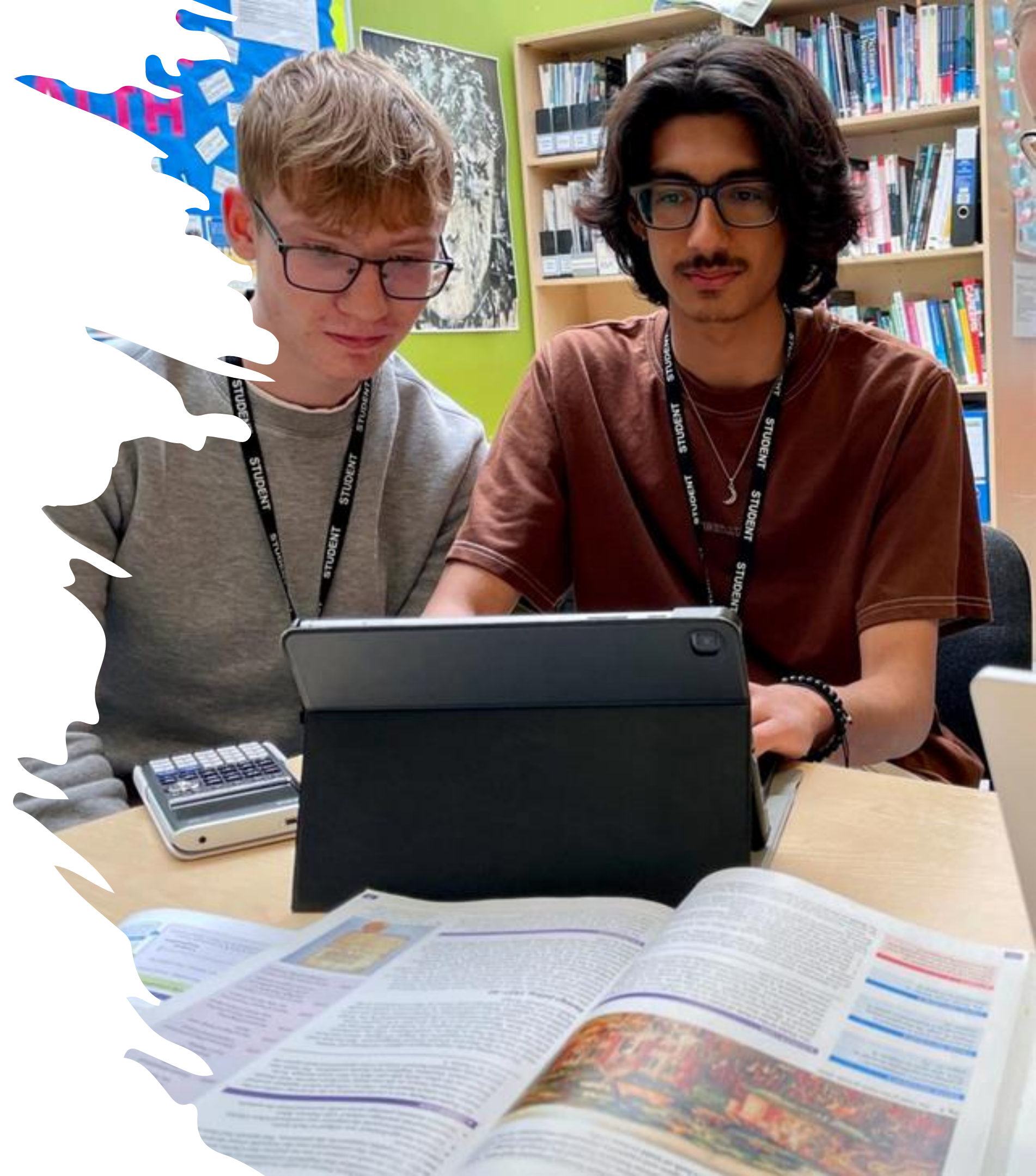
Sixth Forms are different to Colleges in the following ways:

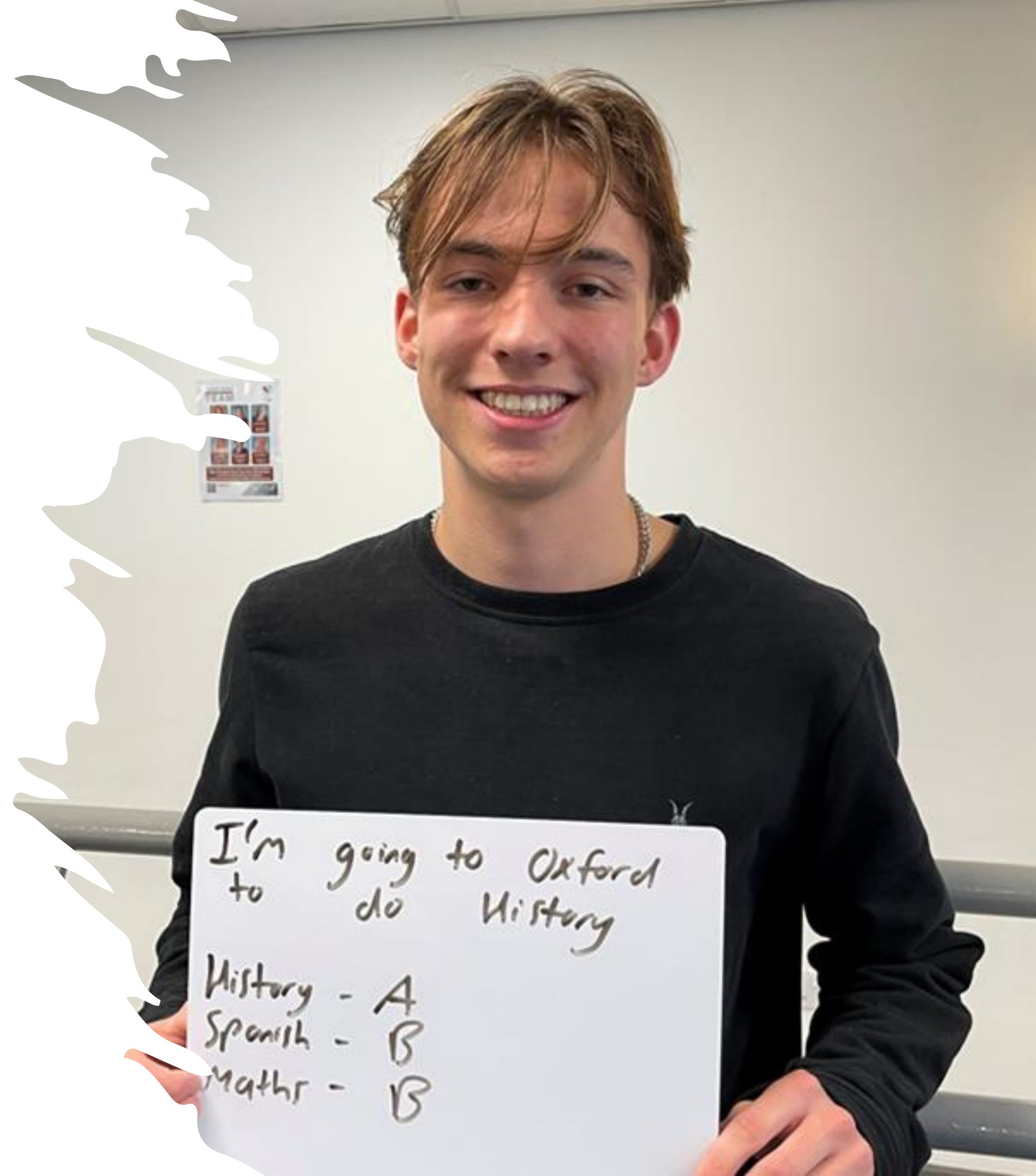
# Entry Requirements

## Subject-specific:

- Grade 6s are required for A Level Maths and Science and a minimum of a grade 4 for other subjects
